

WHY SWEDEN?

Life expectancy in Sweden is among the highest in the world: 79.9 years for men and 83.7 years for women. As a consequence, health and social care for elders are important to Swedish welfare policy. One of the aims of seniors care is to help older people live normal, independent lives. 

DAY 2 TUESDAY 19 MAY

MORNING SESSION / ORIENTATION BRIEFING AND ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION ON SWEDEN AGED CARE SYSTEM AT SKL (Swedish Association of Local Authorities and Regions)

General introduction to the Swedish elder care system

The Swedish Association of Local Authorities and Regions is both an employers' organisation and an organisation that represents and advocates for local government in Sweden. All of Sweden's municipalities, county councils, and regions are members of SKL, which represents them and acts on their initiative.

Bräcke diakonia co-owns the Ersta Sköndal Bracke college. Ersta Sköndal Bräcke University College is dedicated to studies in the fields of social work, nursing, health care, and psychotherapy. They combine practice-centered, professionally oriented research with ethical, historical, welfare rights-related and critically appraising studies on the interaction between society, health, organisation, and the individual.

Bräcke diakona and the Ersta Sköndal Bracke college work closely together with researchers, teachers, and students to develop their businesses. Together they created the care accommodation Hornstull – called "an academic accommodation." In the nursing home, experience and knowledge are as important as the research perspective. The goal of the project is to be able to experience the best dementia care, where they generate new knowledge and implement change using scientific data/research.

DAY 3 WEDNESDAY 20 MAY

FOCUS ON TECHNOLOGY: DAY AT VASTERAS - THE VALLEY OF ROBOTS

MORNING SESSION / ROBOTDALEN

Robotdalen is a catalyst for the development and implementation of new ideas and solutions in robotics, with a focus on new innovations for the field, service, and health care.

MISTEL

The Mistel project is a test bed run by the City of Västerås. MISTEL has been established as a centre of excellence for innovations that contribute to the independence and wellbeing of elders and people with disabilities, and also innovations that contribute to the municipally funded health and personal care services

AFTERNOON SESSION / HÄLLEBORGS ÄLDREBOENDE

Hälleborg äldreboende, which is located in Bäckby, includes a retirement home and a group residence for elders and people with dementia. The recently established facility, which has 100 apartments, is one of Sweden's most modern ones.

DAY 4 THURSDAY 21 MAY

MORNING SESSION / SILVIAHAMMET DEMENSCENTRUM

Stiftelsen Silviahemmet was founded by H.M. Queen Silvia on Valentine's Day 1996. The training of Silvia nurses and training certification of entire units is combined with broad-based training in practical dementia care for the various categories of staff involved in providing care.

Silviahemmet endeavors to make an active contribution to the development of good care provision for people with dementia and their relatives.

AFTERNOON SESSION / KRUSMYNTAN - VARDAGA

Krusmyntan äldreboende, located in Tyresö, has been certified "Silvia" since December 2016. This corresponds to the foundation "Silviahemmet," created on the initiative of Queen Silvia with the aim of training health professionals specializing in the care of people with dementia.

The goal of this nursing home is for the patients to stay active as much as possible. An activity manager takes care of entertaining elders by offering them a program every week, including cooking, music, bingo, gymnastics, walking, etc. In terms of care, the concept of the establishment is based on individualized care, integrity, and freedom of choice.

DAY 5 FRIDAY 22 MAY

MORNING SESSION / ALERIS BATHOJDEN PLAZA

Aleris Boat Hill Plaza is a care facility specializing in the care of elders with dementia.

Opened in March 2011, Aleris Båhöjden Plaza uses the latest research on aging and age-related diseases. The establishment is very spacious, but designed with architecture adapted to the needs of people with dementia, to contribute to the feeling of freedom, the need for framing and clarity.

The Aleris Båhöjden Plaza overlooks the forest and nature, the proximity of nature being an important aspect in the welcome of the residents.

AFTERNOON / LÖJTNANTSGÅRDEN

The Löjtnantsgården residence is managed by Immanuelskyrkans Vård AB and is part of the work of the Immanuel church. The objectives of the facility is to provide individually tailored care based on humanist and Christian values, where there is room for conversation and questions about existence, faith, life and death. Through the Immanuel Church, a deacon and pastors are available to support residents and staff if wanted.



TARIFF

PROGRAM CHANGES

If, despite all their efforts, circumstances compel them, Dialog Consulting (Dialog Health) and their partners reserve themselves the right to modify the program without consulting the participants, who cannot claim any compensation.

PAYMENT TERMS

A payment of at least \$2000 (deposit) must be done at the moment of the registration to secure a place in the delegation.

Delegates may choose between the two payment plans, demanding one or two invoices.

Full balance is due by 31 March 2020 for all price options and payment plans.

All invoices will be sent eletronically by Dialog Consulting (Dialog Health) directly to the email address informed on this registration form.

Dialog Consulting (Dialog Health) will be unable to retain registrations and reservations without full payment by the due date.

CANCELLATION - INCURRED COST

The existence of many intermediates and payment terms imposed by them on the trip organizers justified the charging cancellation fees even more important than the date of departure is near (transfer equivalent to cancellation):

- More than 91 days before departure: no costs
- 90 to 61 days before departure: 50% of the total amount
- 60 to 31 days before departure: 75% of the total amount
- Less than 30 days before departure: 100% of the total amount.

However, if cancellation is made a refund may be considered if a replacement delegate is found.

Any amount due to Dialog Consulting (Dialog Health) cannot be reported on a future trip.

Airline tickets cannot be changed, nor be refunded.
